Eligibility

Applicant must be a school student (grades K-12) who plays an instrument (string, brass, wind, percussion, or piano) or a vocalist who is currently enrolled at a Brazoria County Texas school, or is a resident of Brazoria County participating in an accredited home-schooling program. **Note:** Previous winners in each category may only reapply every-other year on the same instrument.

Only applicants submitting a fully-completed official form with application fee will be considered. **Application deadline is January 14, 2019.**

Auditions

Applicants must attend the auditions on **Sunday, February 10, 2019 at 2 p.m.** in The Clarion Concert Hall located on the campus of Brazosport College.

- Contestants will present a prepared selection **lasting not more than 12 minutes** to demonstrate talent and overall ability.
- The contestant is encouraged to perform with a piano or other accompaniment provided at his/her own expense. **Memorization is optional.**
- All audition pieces must have standard orchestral arrangements that are readily and reasonably financially available for BSO use.
- If selected to perform with the Orchestra, winners must be available for rehearsals and performances with the Orchestra on the following dates: April 4, 11, 18, 25 and 26 (rehearsals begin at 7:00 p.m.) and on April 27, the day of the performance, there will be both an afternoon dress rehearsal and evening performance. Unless otherwise communicated, all rehearsals are at The Clarion. Any exceptions to the rehearsal schedule must be pre-approved by the conductor.

Awards

Cash awards are available for winners in each category for each of two divisions. A junior division is open to those from Kindergarten to Grade 8. Senior division is open to those in Grades 9 – 12. Categories include string, brass, wind, percussion, vocal and piano. Each division's category winner will be eligible for a \$50 cash prize.

The winner selected to receive the Young Artist of the year will receive a \$500 prize. Those who compete may, at the discretion of the conductor, be offered the opportunity to play on stage with the Brazosport Symphony Orchestra on the night of the presentations, **April 27, 2019.**
